Agenda Item 4.1

This agenda item calls for the Board to consider and take possible action to approve an amendment to the Waste Connections contract to increase Bulky Waste Pick up from 2 times a year to 1 time a month at the residences the City provides refuse service. The amendment also extends the contract 3 years past the original date of expiration from June 2020 to June 2023. The new coverage will increase current customer utility bills by approximately .80 cents monthly to provide the monthly Bulky Waste Pick-up.

Recommend the Board approve the amendment to the Waste Connections Contract.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT

This First Amendment to Contract (this "Amendment") is made and entered into as of the __day of September 2018, by and between Waste Connections of Oklahoma, Inc. ("Contractor") and the Choctaw Utilities Authority, a beneficial trust of the City of Choctaw, Oklahoma ("CUA") (Contractor and CUA collectively referred to as the "Parties"). Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings ascribed to them in the Contract (as defined below).

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into that certain Contract, dated March 4, 2014 (the "Contract") to provide Solid Waste collection, disposal, and Recycling services within the City's corporate limits (as such terms are defined in the Agreement);

WHEREAS, the Contract is subject to expiration on June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have negotiated in good faith the terms of an extension to the Contract and mutually desire to extend the Contract as amended by this Amendment.

AGREEMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, and in consideration of these premises and such other lawful consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which each of the parties hereto acknowledge, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. TERM: Contractor and CUA hereby agree that the term of the Agreement is hereby extended for another five (5) years from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2023 (the "Extended Term"). All of the terms of the Agreement shall be applicable in all respects to the Extended Term except as specifically set forth herein.
- 2. Section 1.01 "Additional Items" in the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications section of the Contract, as modified by Addendum One to the Request for Proposals, is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 3. Section 4.00 "Base Solid Waste Collection" in the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications section of the Contract is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"BASE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

Contractor shall collect Residential Waste generated at a Residential Unit and placed in that Unit's Polycart one time each week. Customer shall place the Container (Polycart) within three feet of the curb, swale, and paved surface of the roadway, closest accessible roadway, or other location agreed to by Contractor and Customer that will provide safe and efficient accessibility to Contractor's collection crew and vehicle. Customers shall not overload Polycarts, and the Polycarts shall be loaded such that the lids shall close securely. A customer may request additional Polycart(s), which shall be charged to the Customer at the

rate set forth on Schedule "A." Contractor shall have no obligation to collect any items placed outside the Polycart, except as expressly provided elsewhere herein."

4. Section 5.00 – "Spring and Fall Residential Bulky Waste Collection" in the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications section of the Contract is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"BULKY WASTE COLLECTION

Two times per year, Spring and Fall, the Contractor shall place appropriate containers and/or collection equipment and manpower at specified points designated by the CUA for the disposal of White Goods, furniture, and other large items not conveniently handled by the normal containers. This series is for all billed customers for beautification and clean-up purposes.

In addition, Contractor will collect Bulky Waste from Residential Units once per month, as designated by the Contractor; <u>provided</u>, that the Bulky Waste, brush, and yard trimmings (A) are placed at the curbside no later than 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day, (B) are reasonably contained (brush and yard trimmings must be placed in a container, bag, or bundle), and (C) do not exceed three (3) cubic yards in total volume. Contractor shall only be responsible for collecting, hauling and disposing Bulky Waste, brush, or yard trimmings from those Residential Units that have complied with this Section 5.00."

5. Section 6.00 – "Residential Brush Collection" of the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"RESIDENTIAL BRUSH COLLECTION

Residential customers have the option of placing brush and yard trimmings in a container or bag or bundled not more than four feet in length and weighing 50 pounds and placing such items for collection as part of the monthly curbside Bulky Waste collection set forth in Section 5.00 hereto; provided such items must otherwise meet the specifications for collection set forth in Section 5.00."

- 6. As of the effective date of this Amendment, the rates for Residential Curbside Service Single Container and Residential Curbside Service Fee Per Additional Container, as set forth in Schedule A Base Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal to the Contract, and as modified pursuant to Section 16.02 "Modification to Rates" in the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications section of the Contract, shall each be immediately increased by the sum of Sixty-Nine Cents (\$0.69) per Residential Unit. Such increase shall have no effect on prior modifications to such rates or Contractor's right to further modify such rates as otherwise provided in the Contract.
- 7. The following language shall be added to Section 7.03 "Costs and Records" of the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling General Specifications:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing or Section 7.05 hereof, in the event that costs incurred by Contractor incidental to processing recyclables collected under this contract exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per ton for ten (10) consecutive days, Contractor may, upon providing to CUA reasonable documentation of such processing costs, petition CUA to allow Contractor to pass through the reasonable costs associated with such increased processing fees incurred by Contractor by increasing the rates set forth in Schedule "B" of the Contract. If CUA denies Contractor's petition to pass through such additional processing costs, CUA shall be deemed to have given Contractor its permission to dispose of any recyclable materials subsequently collected by Contractor at a landfill or other waste disposal facility, and such permission shall continue until such processing costs shall fall below Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per ton for sixty (60) consecutive days."

- 8. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed in one or more facsimile or original counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- 9. <u>Ratification</u>. All terms and provisions of the Contract not amended hereby, either expressly or by necessary implication, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 10. <u>Conflicting Provisions</u>. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Contract and this Amendment, the terms of this Amendment shall prevail.
- 11. <u>Authorization</u>. Each party executing this Amendment represents and warrants that it is duly authorized to cause this Amendment to be executed and delivered.
